Please review your priority registration date listed below. Registration priority is determined by grade level (including current semester hours) and alphabetical sequence.

Before registering:

- Contact your academic advisor to schedule an advising appointment.
- Use the **Student Planning Tool**.
- Clear all restrictions/holds on your account.

Important Notes:

- The university may cancel, reschedule, or change course meeting times.
- If a course is canceled, you must follow the add procedure to enroll in a replacement course/section.
- Minimum enrollment may be required for courses to be run.
- If you have registered but cannot attend, you **must** complete the [Decline Enrollment form](#) to cancel your classes and associated charges prior to the start of the term.

- **Seniors (90+ credits by end of Spring 2026)**
 - L–Z: April 15 at 7:00 a.m.
 - A–K: April 15 at 7:30 a.m.
- **Juniors (60–89 credits by end of Spring 2026)**
 - L–Z: April 16 at 7:00 a.m.
 - A–K: April 16 at 7:30 a.m.
- **Sophomores (30–59 credits by end of Spring 2026)**
 - L–Z: April 20 at 7:00 a.m.

- A–K: April 20 at 7:30 a.m.
- **Freshmen (1–29 credits by end of Spring 2026)**
 - A–Z: April 21 at 7:00 a.m.
